Seven Washington hotels on Condé Nast Traveler's 'Gold' list

Seven Washington state hotels have been named to Condé Nast Traveler's "Gold List," the magazine's selection of the best hotels in the world for 2011.

Hotel Murano in Tacoma heads the state list with a score of 93.8 on a 100-point scale.

Condé Nast Traveler recognized nearly 500 hotels on its list for 2011, using data from its annual Readers' Choice Survey to score the facilities by the quality of their rooms, service, food, location, design and activities.

The announcement of the Gold List comes just [one week after Travel + Leisure magazine](#) ranked seven Washington state facilities among its top 500 in the world. Two hotels — the Fairmont and the Four Seasons Hotel in Seattle — were featured on both lists.

Here are the seven Washington state hotels on Condé Nast Traveler's list:

- Hotel Murano, Tacoma — Score: 93.8
- Hotel 1000, Seattle — Score 92.1
- Fairmont Olympic Hotel, Seattle — Score: 89.5
- **Inn at the Market**, Seattle — Score: 89.4
- Salish Lodge & Spa, Snoqualmie — Score 88.2
- Tulalip Resort Casino, Tulalip — Score 88.1
- **Four Seasons Hotel Seattle**— Score: 87.9
